Good and Welfare

- Blake White Wanted to inform everyone that covid restrictions have been moved down to

 public that will affect LEPC members. This site gives users the ability to go by district and they
 can look up physical chemical addresses, he's assuming from Tier II reports. Blake and David
 had nothing to do with the site. Also, Precinct 2 may be having a hurricane workshop, more
 information on that as it becomes available.
