- Emergency Response and Resources – Gustabo Torres: Wanted to introduce himself to the group. Gus is the Baytown Hazmat Coordinator and has been with the City for 17 years.
- Public Education and Information – Connie Tilton – Connie was not present but Robert Marquez gave the update on her behalf. They have spent \$304 out of their budget so far. The Shelter In Place mailer has been sent to the City to include in the upcoming utility bill. They have reviewed three proposals by videographers and have decided to go with one that includes animation. It will be a four minute video for an estimated cost of \$20k. In addition, they are diligently working on developing a school shelter in place program for the fall.


- LEPC Expenditure Report – Misty Bridges presented the monthly expenditure report for June. A motion to accept was made by Matt Trail and seconded by Robert Marquez. Motion carried.
- Incidents to Report: Becky Johnson said there was a gas leak over at one of the schools the other day. They need to have communication with the safety director because people jumped in cars and left. She said there were some communication break downs during the event that they need to address moving forward.
 - David Harmon: BOP had an event in an unoccupied warehouse. They were storing some aqua dams in the facility. A metal bulb broke above them and ignited the aqua dams in the building. The fire was extinguished very quickly.
 - Gus Torres: Gus was wondering if Chevron had an event recently. He felt a boom a couple weeks before this meeting. Charlie said it was a process upset for them that makes a loud noise and then vents.

Good and Welfare

- David Wade – Tropics are getting active with the storm that is entering the gulf. Preparedness time is reduced because the storm is already there. The storm is forecasted to start moving north this week. JIC sends out updates and those can be shared with those you feel need the info. There is no center now so they really can't tell us where it will go, the track is still up in the air. Take a look at all severe weather impacts at your facilities. In addition, Covid 19 procedures are starting to relax in the county buildings. They are still supporting public health at this time but they are prepared if they need to be.
- Larry Cloud – There is an app you can use that gives you the heat stress level in your area. It tells you what to look for and steps you can take to stay safe. Larry can send it out if anyone is interested.
- Gus Torres – ERCOT put out an alert to conserve energy. Make sure you have plans in place in case they start rolling blackouts. Barbers Hill is already doing that for schools to conserve.
